

READING APP – MAKING JUDGEMENTS

CHOOSE

For this child, which borderline sheet
do you need to look at?
(1/2 2/3 3/4 4/5)

HIGHLIGHT

For each AF:

Look at evidence and highlight criteria that
have been met (across both levels)

TICK

Which level is the best fit?

Clear evidence

Use it to decide
which level is best fit
and tick that level

Some evidence but not enough to give lower level

Tick BL (below level)

No evidence

Tick IE
(insufficient
evidence)

When all AFs are ticked - reflect:

BL ticked more than once?

Should you look
at next
borderline down?

Almost all ticks at higher level?

Should you look
at next
borderline up?

IE ticked more than twice?

May need to record
overall level as IE

WHICH LEVEL?

Minimum requirements for each level

	AF1	AF2	AF3	AF4	AF5	AF6	AF7
Level 1	Tick at level 1	Tick at level 1	Some highlighting at level 1				
Level 2	Tick at level 2	Tick at level 2	Some highlighting at level 2				
Level 3		Tick at level 3	Tick at level 3	+ one tick in any other AF at level 3			
Level 4		Tick at level 4	Tick at level 4	+ one tick in any other AF at level 4			
Level 5			Must be at least level 4	+ four ticks in any AF at level 5			

LOW, SECURE OR HIGH?

LOW = Minimum requirements (see above)

SECURE = Minimum requirements PLUS
additional highlighting at this level in most AFs

HIGH = Minimum requirements PLUS
highlighting at this level in (almost) all AFs and
probably some highlighting in the level above

MODERATE ALL STAGES OF THE PROCESS

(compare with evidence in standards files)
