



## High Hurstwood CEP Primary School

### Sport Funding

Sport Funding is a Government funded initiative to be paid to schools over two years. The allocation for High Hurstwood CEP School for the academic year 2013/2014 is £8,425.

Spending of sports funding is ring fenced and areas of allowable expenditure are:

- Hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with primary teachers.
- Supporting and engaging the least active children through new or additional clubs (Change 4Life)
- Paying for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport
- Providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE
- Running sports competitions or increasing pupils' participation in school games
- Buying quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE and sport
- Providing places for pupils in after school sports clubs
