How this worked in practice: St Lawrence, Grands Vaux and Janvrin worked in collaboration to create a knowledge-web using a wiki. St Lawrence school were studying WWII as part of their History curriculum, and each of the year 6 pupils were each given a WWII topic. As homework the children were asked to each research their topic using a range of sources, differentiating their learning to their specific interests and research skills. They were then asked to co-construct the WWII knowledge web wiki by adding what they had found. As a result of the collaborative activities, the children collectively made a knowledge-web of 85 articles which they could then use to explore particular interests and areas of understanding within their History curriculum topic.

By the end of this sequence of work children had developed skills in:

Literacy: Writing, Reading

History: WWII

Learning: Research Skills, Collaborating, Co-Constructing

Next Steps: To provide self and peer review on the contributions made to the wiki, in order to use AfL approaches to extending and improving historical understanding and interpretation.
