



## High Hurstwood CEP Primary School Sport Funding ~ Academic Year 2015/2016

Sport Funding is a Government funded initiative.

The allocation for High Hurstwood CEP School for the academic year 2014/2015 was £8,535, and for 2015/2016 is £8,446.

Spending of sports funding is ring fenced and areas of allowable expenditure are:

- Hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with primary teachers.
- Supporting and engaging the least active children through new or additional clubs
- Paying for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport
- Providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE
- Running sports competitions or increasing pupils' participation in school games
- Buying quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE and sport
- Providing places for pupils in after school sports clubs

## **Impact**

- Through careful spending of our Sports Funding we have increased access to PE and Sport for pupils throughout the school.
- The children are enthusiastic about PE lessons and participate with confidence.
- Year 6 Play Leaders organise daily lunchtime activities for younger pupils.
- We were awarded the Sainsbury's School Games Bronze Award in September 2015.
- The after school sports club run by 'Al4ha Thinking' Sports Coach continues to be very popular (it is consistently the club with the highest 'take-up').
- We have ensured that all pupils have access to an increasing number of sporting activities and events.
- We have also ensured that our Key Stage 2 pupils have had access to an increasing range of competitive events both at inter-House and Inter- school level.
- There has been an improvement in the children's performance at inter-school events and the teams are achieving high places in competitive events.
- We are providing children with opportunities to be selected for North Wealden events.
